Roles at the National Level by IPNSCCC as hosted by MPIDO

Mobilize IPNSCCCs regional representatives in the adoption of the entire structure, the roles and TORs of the IPNSCCC-FLLoCA by partners from the 19 counties; 5-7th Nov, 2023 Venue; Laikipia

Enhance the capacity of Indigenous peoples Organizations from the 7 regions on FLLoCA program including IPs youth and women 7th -10th Nov 2023 Venue; Laikipia

Conduct annual regional forums of IPs representatives from the CCCPC to share experiences and lessons learnt from the counties they represent. The lead IPOs in each of the counties will coordinate together with the regional reps will coordinate these forums

Document and disseminate key lessons learned.

Perform a joint M&E at the County level based on IPs regions.

Establish two technical working groups on different thematic areas ; the place of indigenous knowledge on climate resilience building, the impacts of climate change on Women and children and persons with disabilities, Water technologies

- Support in resource mobilization in collaboration with FLLoCA's PIU.
- Carry out a joint activity with ITAC and FLLoCA's PIU to showcase the success stories at regional and international level forums i.e UNFCCC COP, CBD, AU annual meetings

- Enhance the capacity of the County Climate Change Planning Committee (CCCPC); on planning , monitoring FPIC, value for money, equitable sharing of resources
- Enhance the capacity of the Ward Climate Change Planning Committee and other key stakeholders at the ward level on project management and to carry out social audits on their projects.
- IP-led county forums for dialogues between IPOs, CSOs and other key stakeholders in FLLoCA for experience sharing.
- Development of social audit dashboards to enhance accountability on projects planning, implementation and certification.
